## Highlights




This week everyone has been busy learning in many ways.

## **Local Elections**

*Elections will be taking place in Knowsley on Thursday 2 May 2024. This includes local elections as well as the election of the Combined Authority Mayor and the Merseyside Police and Crime Commissioner.*

*To vote in these elections, you must be registered to vote by 11.59pm on Tuesday 16 April 2024. If you've never registered, have moved address or changed your name, register to vote online at [www.gov.uk/register-to-vote](http://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote) Once you are registered, there are a number of different ways you can vote:-*

**Postal vote:** *If you are not already registered for a postal vote, you need to do so by 5pm on Wednesday 17 April 2024.*

*You can apply online for a postal vote by visiting the Government's website. You will be asked to provide your National Insurance Number.*

*If you are already registered for a postal vote, you don't need to do anything. You will be contacted by the Election Team when your postal vote is due for renewal.*

**Voting by Proxy:** *If you are unable to vote in person and would like someone to vote on your behalf, you can apply for a proxy vote. The deadline for applications is 5pm on Wednesday 17 April.*

**WHY ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL IS SO IMPORTANT**

If a child of compulsory school age is registered at a school it is essential that they attend their school regularly and maintain a pattern of good attendance throughout their school career.

Excellent attendance at school is important to allow a child or young person to fulfil their potential.

Below are just some of the key reasons why it is so important children attend school:

- To learn. To have fun.
- To make new friends.
- To experience new things in life.
- To develop awareness of other cultures, religion, ethnicity and gender differences.
- To achieve. To gain qualifications.
- To develop new skills. To build confidence and self-esteem.
- To have the best possible start in life.

Young people who regularly miss school without good reason are more likely to become isolated from their friends, to underachieve in examinations and/or become involved in anti-social behaviour.

## Staying Safe Online

### Protect your email with a strong password

Your email password should be strong and different from all your other passwords – combine 3 random words to create a password that’s long enough and strong enough.



### Turn on 2-step verification (2SV) for your most important accounts

2SV gives you twice the protection by adding a second step when you log on, so even if cyber criminals have your password, they still can’t access your account. If 2SV is available for an account, the option to switch it on is usually found in the security settings for the account.



### Back up your data

Safeguard your most important data, such as your photos and key documents, by backing them up to an external hard drive or to the cloud.



### Update your devices

Applying security updates promptly will help protect your devices and accounts from cyber criminals. You should turn on ‘automatic updates’ in your device settings if it’s available.
