You will also need a take a copy of your child's Baptismal Certificate to the high school of choice. Please also be aware that if you are making applications to more than one Catholic high school, then you will need multiple copies of your child's Baptismal Certificate.

## **Dogs on School Grounds**


Dogs are not permitted on school grounds under any circumstances. Please do not bring dogs onto school premises even if they are carried.
